

2016 ARRL Field Day Results

This year's Field Day had the most participants since 2012, and an all-time record for the number of entries.

There's a certain rhythm to the sounds an amateur hears on the air. If operating CW, it's easy to tune in to the ebb and flow of the *dits* and *dahs* emerging from headphones. The tones and inflections of the voice "at the other end" always seem to have a familiar pace. The intriguing tones of the various digital modulations can summon a soothing melody as the machine decodes them. These were the sounds experienced June 25 – 26, 2016, during the annual ARRL Field Day operating event.

2016 Field Day Stats

Whether you are a grizzled veteran or a Rookie, the multiple facets of this unique event are a wonderful experience. Each year, thousands of groups and individuals take to the air in what is truly Amateur Radio's version of a social media experience. How Field Day unfolds is different for each and every participant. The tried-and-true traditions of a club in the mountains of North Carolina will be different from the experimental nature of the event hosted by an up-and-coming group in the Pacific Northwest. However you and your group choose to participate in this event, you will find a simple maxim is true: you get out of it what you put into it.

Field Day in the US knows no match for popularity. It is the single most participated in 24-hour Amateur Radio operating event, with a reported 36,729 persons participating in 2,735 entries across the US, Canada, and beyond. That's the most participants since 2012, and the number of entries appears to be an all-time record — not too shabby for a year when sunspots were virtually nonexistent. That record number of entries totaled 1,105,315 contacts logged for the event. That is a decline of about 200K contacts (15%) logged from 2015. The numbers were down for each mode: CW was down 14%, digital was down 3%, and phone was down 17%.

As always, the most popular operating classes are the general Class A entries — those clubs and non-club groups that choose to set up a temporary Field Day site away from their

usual stations or locations — a total of 1,269 (46.4%). They were joined in the "field" by an additional 328 Class B stations (12%). Stations operating from home, either with commercial power (Class D) or emergency power (Class E), made up an additional 861 of


all entries (31.5%). Stations operating as Class F from various EOCs accounted for 184 entries (6.7%). The remaining entries came from the 55 Class C stations operating mobile (2%) or were one of the 38 checklogs received.

New Field Day Bonuses

In the 21st century, we all have to utilize every tool available to help promote Amateur Radio and recruit potential new licensees. To help accomplish the goals of growing the Amateur Radio Service, a new component to Field Day debuted in 2016, with the addition of the social media bonus. Available to any participating club or organized group that welcomed visitors at their location and promoted their participation using one of the popular social media platforms (such as Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram), a large number of groups directed some energy to reaching out

Officer. We often forget to pay attention to many of the small details that go into putting on a successful event. Utilizing a safety officer to monitor everything from safely erecting a tower to proper procedures for keeping the generator fueled and on the air helps define the broad framework of what Amateur Radio brings to the table. Congratulations to those groups that employed a safety officer — great job!


