Adelino's Philippino Kite Instruction Sheet

Make the two folds along the dashed lines, with the dashes inside the crease. Poke the bridle holes with a pin. You may want to reinforce the bridle holes with tape.

Cut a piece of thread 14 inches long to make the bridle. Tie one end of the bridle to each hole. Make a hook out of a paper clip and tie your flying line to the hook.

When making a kite you might want to tie a small piece of ball chain between the hook and the flying line. You might also consider using a swivel hook and a ring in place of the paper clip and ball chain. The swivel will keep the flying line from getting tangled. Ball chain and swivel hooks can usually be purchased at a hardware store.

Attach the bridle to the flying line hook by wrapping the bridle around the hook three or four times. Make sure both legs of the bridle are even
